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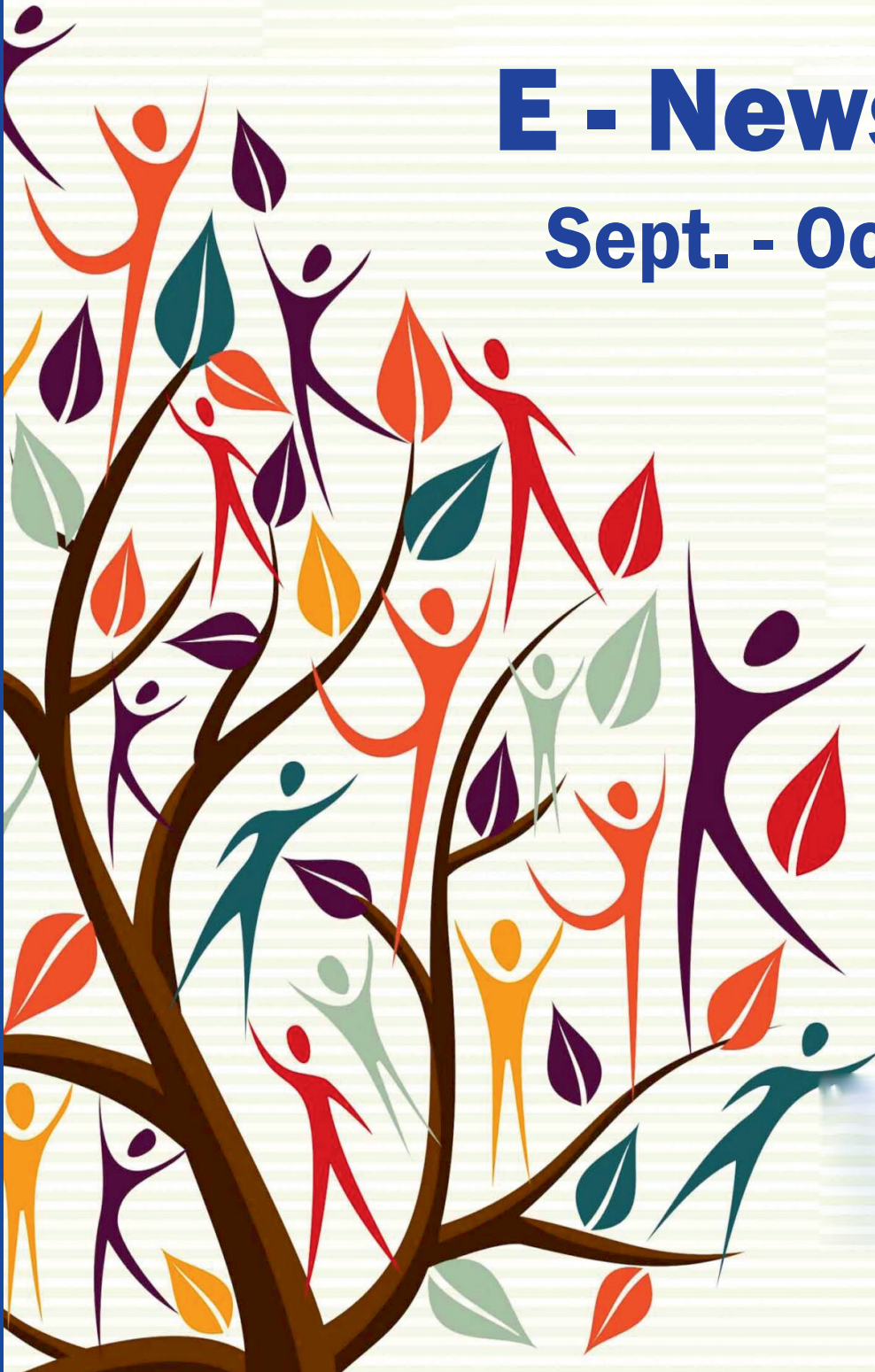

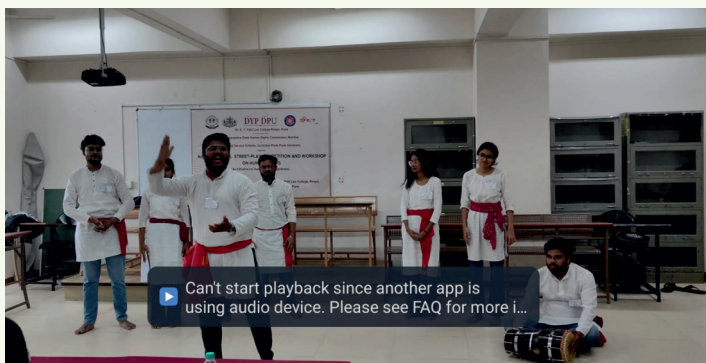
Awareness Session on Organ Transplant and Donation

The speakers enlightened the students about the importance of organ donation, the legal and ethical aspects involved, and the role of awareness in saving lives through organ transplantation. The session also aimed to dispel common myths and misconceptions surrounding organ donation and motivated students to become advocates for this noble cause.

As part of this commitment, students participated in an E-Waste and Plastic Waste Collection Mega Drive organized in collaboration with Janwani and the Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC) on 12 October, 2025.

Students contributed by assisting in the collection, segregation, and awareness activities, motivating local citizens to adopt eco-friendly habits.

Session on Developing Leadership Skills
