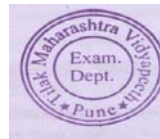

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. A candidate should be present at the examination center on first day 30 minutes before and on remaining days 15 minutes before the examination starts.
2. No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination hall 30 minutes after the examination starts.
3. All the details on the cover page of the answer book should be filled up carefully. You must write your Examination Seat No. only and not your Registration No. on the answer book.
4. Documents such as Hall Ticket, Identity Card, Receipt of Fees etc. are to be carried with and presented at the time of the examination.
5. Seating arrangement will be displayed at the Examination Centre.
6. Examination centre once selected cannot be changed in any circumstances.
