

Eligibility :

A Graduate from any discipline from any recognized University in India or abroad with not less than 50 percent marks is eligible to apply for admission to the Master of Social Work (MSW) degree course. Candidates must have studied under the 10 + 2 + 3 pattern. Concession of 5% marks in graduation for candidates belongs to other than open category.

Candidates who have appeared for the final year examination of the Bachelors' degree can also apply in anticipation of the results provided he / she produces University / College marks' / grades' sheet showing an overall average of the marks mentioned above in first two years of the program taken together. In case he / she is unable to produce either the marks of the first two years, or the final Vidyapeeth examination marks, by the end of the 1st semester his / her admission shall stand cancelled.

At the time of applying, those who are awaiting their results should be required to attach a certificate from the college to the effect that they have appeared for the part III / final year examinations.
