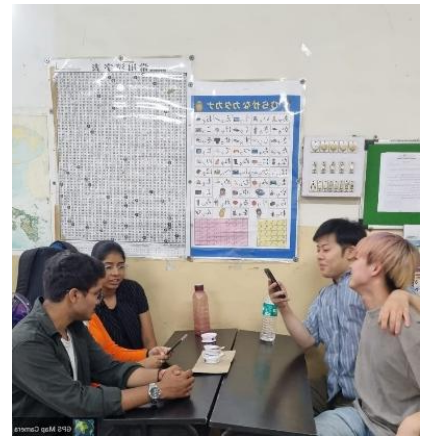

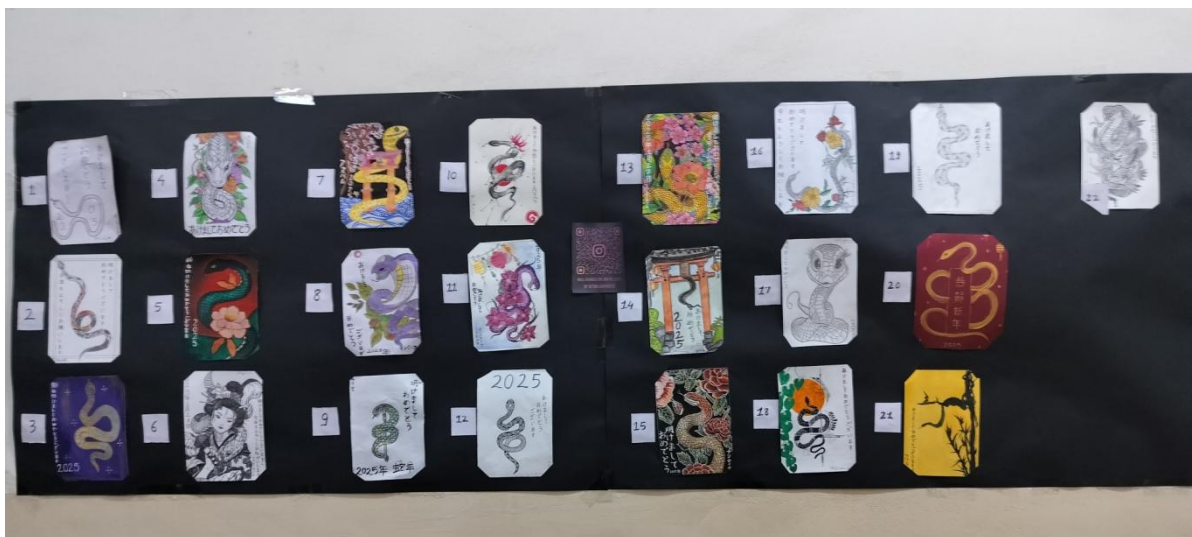
Presentations By students on Various Topics:
