Indology is a discipline that studies India through various sources. The literary, material and oral sources, many a times, help the researchers in reconstructing the different facets of the history of the country. Since the British period numerous scholars have worked with the help of these sources and have reconstructed the history with major dynasties and their tentative dates. The literary sources, both religious and secular, have been analyzed to understand the nuances of the lifestyle of the ancient Indians. The intangible heritage of the country can be understood from this literature. Experts of ancient languages and literature, sometimes, come across new facets of the lifestyle of the ancient people and some fresh data comes to light.

In case of the material sources different archaeological remains like unknown sculptures, habitation sites, temples, coins, inscriptions etc come to light and hitherto unknown information is discovered. Their proper study helps in getting a better understanding of the various socio – economic and religious conditions in that particular region. The oral traditions of some parts of the country are still being documented. Many a times these oral traditions go parallel with the literary and material sources. Hence, to understand the history of a particular region from all perspectives, all these sources need to be studied carefully.

The history of the country as well as the history of the various regions is constantly being updated with the efforts mentioned above. However, there still are many gaps in the history of different parts of the country. Every now and then researchers come across fresh data to reconstruct the history of those regions. Such researches go unnoticed unless they are presented in the form of research papers in the seminars. Hence Shri Balmukund Lohia Centre of Sanskrit & Indological Studies, Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth, Pune has organized a one day National Seminar entitled '**Recent Researches in Indology**' on 23rd March 2018. Papers dealing with fresh research in different fields of Indology can be presented in this seminar. The tentative sub themes for the research papers are- Recent Researches in the fields of 1) Archaeology, 2) Art & Architecture, 3) Epigraphy, 4) Numismatics, 5) ancient literature, 6) Iconography and any other subject related to ancient Indian history and culture.


The abstracts with the registration fees should reach us on or before 17th March 2018. The registration fees will be Rs. 1000/- for paper presenters; Rs. 700/- for TMV faculty members and students; and Rs. 500/- for individuals participating without presenting a paper.
