संस्कृत विशारद (नियमित)

सदर अभ्यासक्रम चार वर्षांचा असून आठ सत्रांमध्ये विभागलेला आहे. सत्र चालू असताना वर्गात आणि प्रत्येक सत्राअखेर विद्यार्थ्यांच्या परीक्षा होतील. नवीन शैक्षणिक धोरणानुसार Major (मुख्य विषय), DSC (विद्याशाखा विशिष्ट वैकल्पिक), AEC (क्षमतावर्धक), SEC (कौशल्यवर्धक) Open Elective (खुला वैकल्पिक) आणि Multidisciplinary (बहुविद्याशाखीय) अशा विविध प्रकारचे विषय या सत्रांमध्ये शिकविले जाणार आहेत.

प्रत्येक सत्रातील विविध विषयांना मिळून एकूण 20 श्रेयांक (Credits) असतील. प्रत्येक श्रेयांकाकरिता 15 तास अध्यापन केले जाते. त्या त्या विषयाच्या श्रेयांकानुसार वेळापत्रकातील तासांचे नियोजन असेल. प्रत्येक विषयाकरिता असलेल्या गुणांचे विभाजन वर्गात घेतल्या जाणाऱ्या सतत मूल्यांकनाच्या चाचण्या (Continuous Evaluation) आणि सत्रांत (Semester End) परीक्षा यांमध्ये केले जाते. काही विषयांना 50 अथवा 100 गुणांची फक्त अंतर्गत परीक्षा असेल. मात्र इतर विषयांना 60 गुणांची अंतर्गत आणि 40 गुणांची सत्रांत परीक्षा असेल. ज्या विषयांच्या परीक्षा अंतर्गत मूल्यमापन आणि सत्रांत अशा दोन्ही प्रकारे होणार आहेत, त्यांना दोन्ही प्रकारच्या परीक्षांमध्ये किमान 35 टक्के गुण स्वतंत्रपणे मिळविणे अत्यावश्यक आहे. सतत मूल्यांकनाकरिता वर्गात होणाऱ्या परीक्षांचे नियोजन संबंधित विषयशिक्षक करतील. गृहपाठ, बहुपर्यायी प्रश्न, मौखिक परीक्षा, लेखी परीक्षा, एखाद्या मुद्यावर सादरीकरण अशा विविध प्रकारे ते वर्गात परीक्षा घेऊ शकतात. प्रत्येक विषयाचा सर्वांगीण अभ्यास व्हावा या दृष्टीने प्रश्नपत्रिकेतील प्रश्न असतील. एखाद्या विशिष्ट भागावर किती गुणांचे प्रश्न ठेवावे याचे संपूर्ण स्वातंत्र्य त्या त्या विषयाध्यापकाला असेल.

सतत मूल्यांकनामध्ये किमान गुण न मिळविल्यास एका वेगळ्या सत्राच्या कालावधीत त्या विषयाची परीक्षा पुन्हा द्यावी लागेल. पुढील इतर सत्रांसोबत ही परीक्षा देता येणार नाही. त्यामुळे विद्यार्थ्यांनी सातत्यपूर्ण अध्ययन करून किमान गुण मिळविणे आवश्यक आहे. सत्राच्या अखेरीस होणाऱ्या परीक्षेत किमान गुण न मिळविल्यास ती परीक्षा मात्र पुढील सत्रातही बॅकलॉग भरून देता येईल.

जे विद्यार्थी नियमितपणे वर्गात उपस्थित आहेत, ज्यांनी सर्व सतत मूल्यांकन चाचण्या दिल्या आहेत, आणि तरीही ज्यांना या चाचण्यांमध्ये 45 टक्क्यांपेक्षा कमी गुण मिळत आहेत, त्यांना कमकुवत (Weak) म्हणून निश्चित करून त्यांच्या प्रगतीकरिता दोषनिवारकअध्यापनाची (Remedial Teaching) व्यवस्था केली जाईल. तसेच ज्या विद्यार्थ्यांनी उत्तम प्रगती करीत 90 टक्क्यांपेक्षा अधिक गुण मिळविले आहेत त्या उत्कृष्ट (strong) विद्यार्थ्यांना प्रोत्साहन दिले जाईल.
