सदर अभ्यासक्रम दोन वर्षांचा असून चार सत्रांमध्ये विभागलेला आहे. सत्र चालू असताना वर्गात आणि प्रत्येक सत्राअखेर विद्यार्थ्यांच्या परीक्षा होतात. प्रत्येक सत्रातील चार विषय अनिवार्य असून एक विषय वैकल्पिक आहे. हा वैकल्पिक विषय वेद, व्याकरण, दर्शन आणि साहित्य यांपैकी एका गटातून निवडायचा आहे आहे. एकदा निवडलेला गट चतुर्थ सत्रापर्यंत बदलता येणार नाही. त्या त्या वर्षी उपलब्ध असलेले गट विभागातर्फे जाहीर केले जातील. किमान विद्यार्थिसंख्या असल्याशिवाय वैकल्पिक विषयांचे अध्यापन केले जाणार नाही.

या अभ्यासक्रमातील काही विषयांना 4 आणि काही विषयांना 2 श्रेयांक (Credits) आहेत. प्रत्येक श्रेयांकाकरिता 15 तास अध्यापन केले जाते. त्या त्या विषयाच्या श्रेयांकानुसार वेळापत्रकातील तासांचे नियोजन असेल. प्रत्येक विषयाकरिता असलेल्या 100 गुणांचे विभाजन वर्गात घेतल्या जाणाऱ्या सतत मूल्यांकनाच्या चाचण्या (Continuous Evaluation) आणि सत्रांत (Semester End) परीक्षा यांमध्ये केले जाते. प्रत्येक विषयाला सतत मूल्यांकनाचे ६० पैकी गुण मिळतील आणि सत्रांत परीक्षा ४० गुणांची असेल. या दोन्ही प्रकारच्या परीक्षांमध्ये किमान ४० टक्के गुण स्वतंत्रपणे मिळविणे अत्यावश्यक आहे. सतत मूल्यांकनाकरिता वर्गात होणाऱ्या परीक्षांचे नियोजन संबंधित विषयशिक्षक करतील. गृहपाठ, बहुपर्यायी प्रश्न, मौखिक परीक्षा, लेखी परीक्षा, एखाद्या मुद्यावर सादरीकरण अशा विविध प्रकारे ते वर्गात परीक्षा घेऊ शकतात. प्रत्येक विषयाचा सर्वांगीण अभ्यास व्हावा या दृष्टीने प्रश्नपत्रिकेतील प्रश्न असतील. एखाद्या विशिष्ट भागावर किती गुणांचे प्रश्न ठेवावे याचे संपूर्ण स्वातंत्र्य त्या त्या विषयाध्यापकाला असेल.

सतत मूल्यांकनामध्ये किमान गुण (२४) न मिळविल्यास एका वेगळ्या सत्राच्या कालावधीत त्या विषयाची परीक्षा पुन्हा द्यावी लागेल. पुढील इतर सत्रांसोबत ही परीक्षा देता येणार नाही. त्यामुळे विद्यार्थ्याने सातत्यपूर्ण अध्ययन करून ६० पैकी किमान गुण मिळविणे आवश्यक आहे. सत्राच्या अखेरीस होणाऱ्या ४० गुणांच्या परीक्षेत किमान गुण (१६) न मिळविल्यास ती परीक्षा मात्र पुढील सत्रातही बॅकलॉग भरून देता येईल.

जे विद्यार्थी नियमितपणे वर्गात उपस्थित आहेत, ज्यांनी सर्व सतत मूल्यांकन चाचण्या दिल्या आहेत, आणि तरीही ज्यांना या चाचण्यांमध्ये ४५ टक्क्यांपेक्षा कमी गुण मिळत आहेत, त्यांना कमकुवत (Weak) म्हणून निश्चित करून त्यांच्या प्रगतीकरिता दोषनिवारक अध्यापनाची (Remedial Teaching) व्यवस्था केली जाईल. तसेच ज्या विद्यार्थ्यांनी उत्तम प्रगती करीत ९० टक्क्यांपेक्षा अधिक गुण मिळविले आहेत त्या उत्कृष्ट (advanced) विद्यार्थ्यांना प्रोत्साहन दिले जाईल.
