Following points were discussed in the meeting:

- 1. Mrs.Seema Sathe represented Dr.Madhuri Shelke in her absence with permission of chair.
- 2. Dr.Joshi informed all IQAC members that AQAR 2017-18 is successfully submitted to NAAC on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2018 and the same is acknowledged by NAAC. He also informed all the members that next year onwards online AQAR filing is made mandatory from NAAC. New online AQAR format given to members for information. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor instructed IQAC Team to circulate the new online AQAR format to all the HOD's of the Academic Departments for their information and further reference. Dr.Sathe suggested that trail on this online AQAR format can be taken with the data available for the AQAR 2017-18.
- 3. Dr.Joshi also kept Monthly report format prepared by IQAC team in the meeting for approval. He also suggested that all Departments should fill in this format the send it to IQAC at the end of every month. This will make data collection and maintenance easier. The same was approved and accepted by all the members. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor asked IQAC team to send the same to all the Departments and departments are expected to fill it send it by August end.
- 4. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor sir said that now we should encourage our teaching staff and students to publish their papers in SCOPUS or WEB OF SCIENCE. Dr.Geetali Tilak-Mone informed committee about publishing papers in 'Web of Science'. She mentioned that she had asked concerned about the quotations and details about publishing papers in the above journal.   - q. Awareness campaign on National Voters day on 25<sup>th</sup> January
