Following points were discussed in the meeting:

1. Primary agenda of this meeting was to take review of the AQAR filled up till now and to complete & recheck the information written.
2. It was decided that 1 criterion to be given to 1 member for checking & verification / rectification of information filled in.
3. Dr.Joshi gave dead line – 2nd August by 12.00pm for submission of criterion after checking.
4. Different Innovative & Best Practices of Vidyapeeth were discussed in meeting and 1 Innovative (Twin Heart Meditation) and 3 best practices (Mediclaime to employees, Best use of Library, Award to best Sanskrit Teacher) were finalized and Mrs.Geetali Mone was given a responsibility to prepare a write up for the same.
5. Discrepancy was found in Criterion-I of Part-B so Mrs.Prajyakti Bakre was asked to look into it and to confirm the same with Authorities.
6. Mr.Vishal Jadhav was asked to re-confirm major and minor projects and there funding amounts.
7. Responsibility of checking & filling up information regarding Infrastructure & Learning resources was given to Mr.Rishikesh Kelkar and Dr.Sathe took responsibility for editing & checking information related to Student support & Progression.
8. Dr.Sathe put forth request received from TMV Art circle to form a student council for the academic year 2016-17 to encourage students to conduct different activities for students of Vidyapeeth. The proposal was accepted unanimously. Dr.Joshi informed members that this can be done in 2 ways – by student elections and selection by Vidyapeeth Authorities. He added that we will go by selection method. He suggested the constitution of council can be: 3 students who are academic toppers, 1 cultural representative, 1 sports representative, 1 social work representative and 2 ladies representatives having outstanding contribution in Vidyapeeth activities & 1 research scholar.
9. Dr.Sathe suggested that this year IQAC must take some initiative for conducting FDP programmes & research related workshops/seminars which is a major thrust for higher education. Suggestion was welcomed by all the members.
10. It was also decided to meet on 3rd August 2016 at 2.30pm to take an over view of complied AQAR.
