Minutes of the meeting

An online meeting of IQAC was held on Thursday, 11th November 2021 at 3.00 p.m.

The following points were presented for discussion at length and decisions were taken unanimously.

1. To take a note of OBE ranking received by the Vidyapeeth

Decision: IQAC/2021/19

Noted. Dr. Geetali Tilak, Chairman, IQAC briefed all the members about the OBE ranking activity. The OBE (Outcome Based Education) ranking recognizes the efforts taken by the Institutes for achieving excellence in quality education and implementation of latest teaching-learning methodologies, including out based education model. We decided to participate in this survey based ranking and submitted our data to R. World Institutional Ranking in August 2021. It was informed that our Vidyapeeth is positioned in the 'A5 Band' in Institution of Academic Excellence category.

2. Review of ISO Internal audit conducted.

Decision: IQAC/2021/20

The Vidyapeeth decided to acquire ISO certification and accordingly decided to go for the ISO 21001 certification which is for education organizations. It is decided that, initially the five departments, Viz. Law, Nursing, Sanskrit & Indology, Physiotherapy and Journalism and Mass Communication will be involved in the ISO process. The requisite forms and formats had already been prepared and circulated; the concerned faculties have been sensitized about the process and its timeline. The meetings are held regularly. The work is progressing as per the timeline.

3. Review of activities organized and carried out by TMV Sports League.

Decision: IQAC/2021/21

Dr. Pranati Tilak took a review of activities of TMV Sports League. She informed that, as a part of 100th Anniversary celebrations of the Vidyapeeth, the TMV Sports League was established to carry out various sports events in the Vidyapeeth. The motive was to involve all the teaching and non teaching members that will build harmonious relations and

sportsman spirit in them. There are nine teams in this Sports League. Each team has been given a specific colour and the members of each team are allocated with their respective colour T-shirt. Sports activities such as Marathon, Tug of War, Badminton, Volleyball, Cricket, Fun games, Fitness Activities, Hill Run, etc. have been arranged. Some events are already over and some are upcoming. The members expressed that everyone liked this initiative which is giving them some relaxation and positive energy and decided that such an activity will be carried out every year during a specific period, mostly on Saturdays and Sundays.

4. Preparation of AQAR 2020-21

Decision: IQAC/2021/22

Review of data compilation work for the AQAR 2020-21 was taken. The queries reg. some metrics were discussed and resolved. It is estimated that the entire data will be ready till 10th of January 2021. A review will be taken once again and the data will be uploaded on the NAAC portal within the stipulated time.

5. Policy for online and offline examination for the Academic Year 2021-22.

Decision: IQAC/2021/23

Though the educational institutions have started physical working and the conditions are favourable to conduct offline examinations, there are still some containment zones / areas. Also all the students are not fully vaccinated for Covid 19. Hence it has been decided to conduct the examination in mixed mode, i.e. offline and online. The fully vaccinated students, residing in safe zones will only be allowed to appear for offline examinations. Examination of external students will be conducted in online mode only.

6. To take a review of National and International Research Projects sanctioned to various departments.

Decision: IQAC/2021/24

Dr. Abhijit Joshi told that, the Department of Ayurved and Yoga has been sanctioned a research project from CCRAS under IMR scheme. He also informed that proposal for Centre of Excellence to Lokmanya Tilak International Centre for fundamental research in Ayurved and Yoga will also be submitted to Ministry of Ayush very soon. Also, a proposal to Department of Scientific and Industrial Research (DSIR) will be submitted for recognition of Ayurved Department. Dr. Geetali Tilak briefly informed about the project "Revisiting contribution of Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak in nation building and its contemporary relevance (1914-1920 A.D)" sanctioned by Indian Council of Historical Research (ICHR) to Department of Journalism and Mass Communication.

7. To take a note of Vidyapeeth's decision for Participation in NIRF 2022 ranking.

Decision: IQAC/2021/25

Dr. Abhijit Joshi informed that registration process for NIRF 2022 ranking has been started and the last date for registration is 30th November 2021. The Vidyapeeth has decided to register for participation in NIRF 2022 ranking and the registration process will be completed in the next week.

8. To take a note of publication of Critical Edition of Charak Nidan Sthana by Department of Ayurveda.

Decision: IQAC/2021/26

Dr. Abhijit Joshi informed that the CCRAS, New Delhi published a book 'Critical Edition of Charak Nidan Sthana' on the auspicious Ayurveda Day which is based on the completed research project of the same title. The book will be released for open access at the hands of Hon'ble Chancellor very soon.
