

CIRCULAR

You are cordially invited to attend 36th Convocation ceremony of Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth, which will be held on Saturday 26th March 2022 at 10 am at Vidyapeeth Campus ground, Mukundnagar, Gultekadi, Pune with implementation of Government Guidelines for Covid 19. In this Convocation ceremony Degree Certificates will be issued to only those students, who have Passed their final year Degree/ Diploma Exam during December 2020 & May 2021. Kindly note the following instructions and extend your Co-operation for the accomplishment of the programme.

1. While arriving for Convocation Ceremony, students should bring Original Convocation fee Receipt/Challan and Photo Copy of final Years Mark sheet of Degree/Diploma. Degree Certificate & Uttariya will not be issued without Receipt of Convocation Fees and Photo Copy of marksheet.
2. Time for distribution of Degree Certificate will be 8:30 am to 9:30 am.
Place : Vaidic Sanshodhan Mandal, In front of Jayantrao Tilak Sankul,
Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth Campus, Mukundnagar, Gultekdi, Pune-37.
3. The Students who have applied for Degree Certificates by post, will receive their Degree Certificates by the end of April 2022. All such students would not be given Degree Certificates by hand on the day of Convocation.
4. Students will be provided Uttariya (i.e. Ceremonial Dress,) which is to be attired throughout the function.
5. The students who have passed their final year exam previous to the exam of Dec-2020 & May 2021, will be issued their Degree Certificates during 29/03/2022 to 30/03/2022. The said students will not get their Degree Certificates on the day of Convocation Ceremony.
6. If student himself is unable to attend the Convocation Ceremony, he should give his/her Signed Authority Letter mentioning the Name & Mobile number of person who can collect his/her Degree Certificate. The person who will accept the Degree Certificate on behalf of the student, should bring any one copy of the following :- Aadhaar Card, Election Card, Driving License, Pan Card, Passport as a identity proof. The Vidyapeeth will not responsible for a Degree Certificate issued to a person against the authority letter.
7. Wearing a face mask is compulsory for all during the Convocation Ceremony. Also carry Your Covid Vaccination Certificates.
