
## Notification - Ph. D. Admissions

• Exemption from Entrance Examination (Written)

The candidates fulfilling one of the following conditions will be exempted from the written entrance examination:

- a) Qualified in GATE/SET/NET/JRF examination of the apex bodies as CSIR/UGC/ICAR/ICMR/DBT only.
- b) M. Phil. degree completed from any recognized university and whose admission at M. Phil. was confirmed on the basis of entrance examination. However such candidates will have to apply in the prescribed format with requisite fee for appearing for interview.
- c) Regular full time faculty members (approved by recognized university) with minimum 10 years teaching experience in relevant field/subject OR candidates having Master degree in relevant subject with minimum 55% marks and atleast 15 years experience in corporate sector (for

management subject) at executive level after completing masters degree.

Written test - 100 marks

Interview - 50 marks

The Entrance (Written) Examination shall have the following four components:

- a) Research Methodology (Weightage 40%)
- b) Concerned subject (Weightage 30 %)
- c) Functional English Language (Weightage 15%)
- d) Functional Knowledge of Computers (Weightage 15 %)
- The nature of the examination shall be MCQ/ Descriptive type.
- The Passing criteria for Entrance Exam. is 50%.

### Nature/Pattern of Entrance Examination Question Paper

- Duration of the Paper 3 hours
- Total Marks 100

### **Interview:**

 The successful candidates in Entrance Examination and the <u>candidates</u> who are exempted from the written Entrance Examination will be <u>eligible to appear for the interview</u> before the interview committee. The candidate will be judged on the following parameters -- Descende Antitude (b) Analytical Ability of Communication shills

a) Research Aptitude b) Analytical Ability c) Communication skills
